We continued our journey in central Australia and first stop was at Lake Hart, one of the largest Salt Lakes in Australia.





We arrive Cairns and here we spend three days. In Cairns we went to several waterfalls, such as the famous Millaa millaa.






We also went to the Great Barrier Reef and went scuba diving. Later that evening we got to explore the Cairns Night Markets.
